

COACHING EXCELLENCE - PERFORMANCE NOMINATION CRITERIA

The Award period for the 2023 Tennis NSW Awards is September 2022 - August 2023.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for consideration the nominee must hold a Tennis Australia recognised qualification (High Performance preferred), hold a Working With Children check, a clean National Police Check and be an Australian citizen or permanent resident.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection panel will consider the following in assessing and comparing nominations:

Note: information regarding the coach's and player's program will remain confidential and will only be seen by the selection panel.

- The quality of the high performance program provided by the coach
- Results, rankings, and ranking improvement of players during the Award Period
- Submission of an individual player's program during the Award Period which will include aspects of or all of the following:
 - Player profile (including player goals, competencies and deficiencies as per the Tennis Australia Athlete Development Matrix and / or Believe performance coach framework)
 - The coach has worked with the athlete for a minimum of 6 months, demonstrated by being the assigned coach for at least 10 professional events
 - Specific coaching program delivered to players during the Award Period
 - Player tournament schedule
 - Player results and ranking improvements
 - Player plan for next 12 months
- All entries must supply three high-res photos and/or video footage supporting their nomination

SELECTION PROCESS

Only information provided in the nomination forms and the supporting information attached to the submission will be considered by the selection panel. For nomination forms and relevant supporting information to be considered, nominators **must** submit the nomination form through the online platform. Supporting documentation can be submitted via the online form as well as three (3) high-resolution photo of the nominee or video.

Tennis NSW reserves the right to submit nominations for each award category.

The selection panel in its absolute discretion will determine all decisions in relation to the 2023 Tennis NSW Awards (including any questions in relation to eligibility). All decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered.

As part of the selection process, the finalists may receive a site visit to observe their coaching program in actions and/or a phone interview to discuss the coaching program.
