Qld Schools Orienteering Medal races:

- Sprint Distance: Sat 19 Sep OY4 QLD Sprint Champs Nudgee College
- Long Distance: Sun 20 Sep OY8 Rifle Range, Ripley
- School students may compete in the following age categories: M11, W11, M13, W13, Jnr Boys, Jnr Girls, Snr Boys, Snr Girls. (Age is determined at 31 December 2020).
- Particular courses will be set for each age group and announced on Eventor.

Qld Schools Orienteering Team

- This will be an "honour team" in 2020 rather than a travelling team, since the Australian Champs 2020 have been cancelled.
- School students wishing to be considered for the team should compete in a minimum of 3
 OY events in 2020 (see list below). The team will be announced after the final OY event in September.
- Minimal changes have been made to the Selection Policy to adjust for the situation in 2020.
