Project Description	Continue Linear Reserves partnership project to protect critically endangered GEW and NTG of the Victorian Volcanic Plains on roadsides, rail reserves and cemeteries.
	Extend the current program to establish native seeds in small patches of bare ground post planned burns and targeted weed control. Seed addition is required to reduce weeds from re-established and promote more coverage and diversity of native species
	Small scale (low cost) restoration will occur via hand direct seeding disturbed areas within high quality grasslands. Seed can be collected from other linear reserves or purchase as needed.
