



PATRICK EAST SWANSON DOCK – OPTIBOOK IMPLEMENTATION

Terminal Communication #1

Patrick Terminals, East Swanson Dock will be moving to OneStop's new Optibook VBS platform on Sunday, 3 December 2023. There will be changes when containers are available for collection, free time period calculation and the way containers are booked. There are no changes to the manifesting process.

Availability and Storage Start dates

'Availability' and 'Storage Start' dates will now be set at the container level, not against the vessel.

'Availability' – the date and time from which a container is available to be picked up from the terminal subject to the clearance of holds and/or storage. Note that there may be a time difference between the discharge time of a container and the 'Availability' time. You will not be able to book a slot for a container until it is made available by the terminal.

'Storage Start' – the date and time from which storage is applicable. Note that once set, this date and time will not change, therefore any additional free storage, if applicable, will be factored in when calculating storage.

Estimated Discharge

To assist with planning, Patrick will provide the estimated discharge time for your containers which will be shown in your Container List, this information is provided in real-time and is populated by the Terminal Operating System. If our order of work is adjusted, the estimated discharge time is updated immediately and will be visible in the Container List.

Bookings

VBS Bookings will be made through the Container List in OneStop VBS. You can only make a booking for a container that is 'Ready'. You can set up email notifications in your Container List to notify you when a container has reached a 'Ready' status.

For an import container, 'Ready' is when the 'Availability' date and time for the container is confirmed. Note: you can make a booking for a container which is held, however you will not be able to manifest the container until it is clear. You will be able to hover over the red dot in the Container List to view the active holds on a container. When the container becomes clear, a green dot will display.

For an export container, 'Ready' is when the PRA has been accepted. You will be able to 'pre-book' drop off TBA containers. To book a drop off TBA, you will need a 'Ready' pick up or drop off container to get you to the 'Book Container Slots' screen. You don't need to book the 'Ready' container in order to book the TBA. If you do not have a 'Ready' container in your Container List, you can add a 'dummy' drop off container to your Container List and edit the size, vessel, voyage #, commodity and full/empty fields in order for it to become 'Ready'. You can then use this container to get you to the 'Book Container Slots' screen. Note you will not be able to book this container, you will need to select the TBA container to make your drop off booking. There is a limit of two TBA bookings per time zone per carrier. Once your real container is PRAd, you can edit the booking in the Booking List to attach it to the pre-booked slot.
