NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* and Australian Sailing (AS) Special Regulations (SR) Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats.
- 1.2 RRS Appendix P, will apply, amended as follows:
P2.3 shall not apply and P2.2 applies to all penalties after the first penalty, modified as follows: P2.2 will apply to the second and any subsequent penalties.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.
- 1.4 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the Festival of Sails regatta office, and may be on the RGYC regatta website [HERE](#).

2 ADVERTISING:

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the International Cadet Class whose skipper and crew are members of a Cadet Class body that is affiliated with the International Cadet Class association. Additionally, competitors shall be members of a Club affiliated with Australian Sailing, or their own country's National sailing body.
- 3.2 Eligible boats shall enter online electronically only, through the entry website [HERE](#) by 28th January 2023.

4 FEES

4.1 The entry fee is included in the 6th Fleet membership. All skippers competing need to be current financial members of 6th Fleet.

5.3 On the scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 16:27.

6 MEASUREMENT AND SAFETY INSPECTION

Each boat shall hold a valid current bouyancy card and comply with the International Cadet class rules. Spot inspections may occur if required.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the briefing and will be available online [HERE](#).

8 VENUE:

Racing will be conducted on Corio Bay adjacent to the Royal Geelong Yacht Club.

9 COURSES:

The courses to be sailed will be described in full in the Sailing Instructions.

10 SCORING:

10.1 Ten (10) races are scheduled, of which three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 There will be No drops in the scoring system

11 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall register with regatta management at registration. All support boats must carry a working VHF radio able to be tuned to channels 69, 71, 72, 73 & 77, as well as be prepared to assist the race committee if requested to do so until cleared to leave the course area. Support boats and coaches shall abide by the Coaching code of conduct, which is available on the RGYC regatta website [HERE](#), as well as the International Cadet Association website [HERE](#).

It is recommended that all support boats have propeller guards fitted.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as described below:

1st place skipper and crew
2nd place skipper and crew
3rd place skipper and crew

Other trophies may be awarded at the discretion of Organising Authority.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14 INSURANCE:

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Aus. \$10,000,000 including racing risk per event or the equivalent.

15 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in this Event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authorities and the sponsors of this Event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and, in all material, related to the said event without compensation.
