Our uniform is a sign of our community and as such children are expected to be in the correct uniform at all times.

Summer uniform is to be worn in Terms 1 and 4. Winter uniform is to be worn in Terms 2 and 3.

All uniform requirements apart from shoes are available at **Lowes** located at 43 Mirrabooka Square Shopping Centre, 43 Yirrigan Dr, Mirrabooka. School bags and library bags can also be purchased from Lowes.

Parents will be contacted if their child is in breach of the uniform policy.

The following stipulations apply for all students at all times.

The following supulations apply for all stadents at all times.		
	Hair, for both health reasons and appearance, is to be neat and tidy.	
Hair	Shoulder length hair is to be tied back.	
	 Fringes are to be above the eyebrows or clipped back. 	
	 Hair colour is to be kept natural (no tints, streaks, tips etc.) 	
	 Hairstyles should be of a conservative nature (no tracks, hawks, undercuts, tails, 	
	mullets, partly shaved/close-cut hair etc.)	
	Hair should be no shorter than number 3 cut.	
	 Minimal hair product/gel may be used. 	
	Hair ties, clips, scrunchies and ribbons and plain headbands must all be white, navy	
	blue or light blue in colour.	
Jewellery	For safety and security reasons, it is recommended that no jewellery be worn. The	
	school accepts no responsibility for loss or damage of jewellery.	
	Children are permitted to wear:	
	A watch.	
	A maximum of one earring in each ear must be worn in the lobe, sleepers or discrete	
	studs only.	
	 A gold/silver necklace with a small Christian religious medallion or cross, kept tucked 	
	in shirt/dress (no leather or neoprene bands, etc.)	
	A Medic Alert bracelet.	
	Nail polish and make-up are not permitted.	
Other	 If some accident or problem prevents children from wearing their full uniform on any 	
	particular day, parents need to send a note or email of explanation.	
	Hats are part of the uniform and need to be worn every day while the children are on	
	the school premises – including before and after school – NO HAT, NO PLAY	
	The St Kieran school bag is the preferred option for children in Years 1-6. If choosing	
	to use another bag, it must be no larger than the official school bag.

FREE DRESS GUIDELINES

- Shoes/sandals with flat heels must be worn.

- Tops must cover the shoulders, back and midriff.
- Clothing with inappropriate logos, images, wording must not be worn.
- Hair must be tied up.
- School hats are to be worn.
