There are two instances of 'GEIDELBERG DMITRI/MR16/04/23' involving international travel from Wellington to Colorado. Please indicate if this is a return ticket or two people and how much the total travel cost was.

Response: 'GEIDELBERG DMITRI/MR16/04/23' refers to return flights for one person: Dimitri Geidelberg, Policy Team Leader, Space Policy & Sector Development. Air Fares were NZD\$11,302.39 and there was an additional \$125.00 travel agency fee to make an international booking.

Please outline what the dates of travel were.

Response: 16-20 April 2023.

What event was this travel for?

Response: MBIE delegates travelled to attend the annual Space Symposium held in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

In addition to the plane tickets, what was the cost of taxis, accommodation (air bnb), and event registration for this trip.

Response: The table below includes costs for Dimitri Geidelberg as well as costs for two other MBIE staff. The two other staff members' costs were not captured by your previous information request as their costs were met outside the 'New Zealand Space Agency cost codes'. As per my letter of 31 July, 'New Zealand Space Agency cost codes' was interpreted as the costs codes covering MBIE's Space Policy & Sector Development team and the Space Regulatory Systems team. Please see the break downs for the cost information requested for the three delegates who attended the conference as follows:

Also, what was the purpose of the NZSA's attendance at this event?

Response: The Space Symposium is one of the largest annual international space conferences with a heavy government focus. MBIE attended primarily to efficiently attend multiple face-to-face bilateral meetings with overseas government officials, companies, and research entities in one place and secondarily to support New Zealand entities meeting the same.

MBIE officials did not host any events at the symposium, but New Zealand Trade and Enterprise hosted an event where a NZSA banner was displayed. An MBIE staff member did deliver a speech at this event but there were no costs directly associated to MBIE from attending. MBIE staff were present to facilitate engagements between New Zealand and international stakeholders and the association with the 'New Zealand Space Agency' brand was intended to encourage attendance from overseas counterparts.

Please explain what the 'Reimbursement of costs' for \$8,156 is. To what does it refer, what service was offered?

Response: The reimbursement of costs is not related to the Space Symposium conference. These costs relate to the reimbursement of operational costs to Auckland University of Technology for transitional arrangements for continuity of essential geodetic services, in relation to Auckland University of Technology's withdrawal from the Warkworth Radio Astronomical Observatory.

To what does the Domestic Travel cost 'FCM March Consolidation inl accrual' for \$2,912.95 refer?

Response: This transaction is an accrual within our bookkeeping system that is reversed in the following months.
