# Additional Child and Youth support from ADL

ADL has been awarded temporary additional funding for a 12-month period to help address the current pressures and wait times in Southland and Central Otago for children and youth seeking support for moderate to severe mental health, alcohol and drug and/or co-existing issues.

This additional funding will support child and youth accessing this service whilst the Time for Change – Te Hurihanga project team completes the co-design process to implement a long-term sustainable solution that addresses the growing demand for these services.



# **Project update: Central Lakes Crisis Support Service**

It's been three months since the <u>new Central Lakes crisis support service</u> launched in April and so far the provider, Central Lakes Family Services, is predominantly helping people who are experiencing a lot of stress and low mood anxiety due to situational factors - meeting basic needs, economic pressure, housing, family stressors and dynamics, and feeling isolated.

Clinical Manager Fiona Young says that the key benefit of the new service is being able to extend immediate wraparound support to someone in crisis.

"Seeing people at the point of crisis enables us to provide early intervention, support and strategies to minimise their distress.

"Having that layer of immediate support can make a lot of difference in reducing someone's isolation and improving their wellbeing and coping mechanisms. It can also help reduce anxiety and depression.

"We're working closely with the Specialist Mental Health service – we have daily team meetings with them as well as a weekly leadership meeting to track progress and discuss any issues.

"The next step is planning for a small crisis respite facility which we're hoping to open later this year," says Fiona.

For people in the Central Lakes area needing crisis support, the service can be accessed in one of two ways - via a referral from Te Whatu Ora Southern's Specialist Mental Health and Addiction (MHA) team, which is available to call 24/7, or via a referral from their GP.
