

GPSI Skin Referral Process

Cancer Type

- Suspected Melanoma on Dermoscopy or clinical features suspicious for melanoma.
- Rare Malignant Tumours
- Invasive SCC Head / Neck
- Keratoacanthoma / EFG (Elevated Firm Growing) lesion
- Aggressive BCC Head / Neck (Micronodular, Sclerosed, Infiltrating)
- Nodular BCC in 'H zone'
- Nodular BCC ≥10mm Head / Neck outside 'H zone'
- Poorly differentiated or size ≥20mm SCC Trunk / Limbs
- SCC insitu Head / Neck (if topical treatment not indicated or failed topical treatment)
- Nodular BCC <10 mm Head / Neck outside of 'H zone'
- Nodular BCC ≥20mm outside Head/ Neck
- Invasive SCC on lower leg
- Moderately and well differentiated SCC <20mm Trunk / Limbs
- BCC superficial Head / Neck (if topical treatment not indicated or failed topical treatment)
- BCC outside of Head/Neck
- ≥10mm Trunk / Arms/ Upper leg
- >5mm Hands / Feet/ Lower leg
- All other BCC Trunk / Limbs
- SCC insitu Trunk / Limbs
