Eligible Entrants	Entry is open to current Deakin University students If you are under 18, you must get approval from your parent/guardian before you enter. Employees of Deakin and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter.
Competition Period	The competition commences at 9.00 am AEST on 07/07/2023 and closes at 11.59 pm AEST on 08/09/2023.
How to Enter	 Entrants must: Either individually or as a team, submit a design for a Deakin Alumni Excellence trophy with adherence to the design criteria and a short (up to 30second) video explaining the significance of the design via the submission form:
Selection of Winners	Winners will be determined at Geelong Waterfront Campus on 22/09/2023 at 11am. Winners will be selected by a panel of judges assessing each entry based on (a) creativity; (b) adherence to the design brief and brand outline; (c) the ability to have the physical trophy produced from the artwork provided.
The Prize/s	 There is [1] in total, to be drawn in the following order: First prize = the artwork will be the design used for the 2024 Alumni Awards trophy and presented to the Alumni Excellence recipients (modifications may be made to the winning design in consultation with the winners during the production phase). A single payment for copywrite release of the artwork design will be awarded to the winning designer, or the total prize pool shared amongst the design team if submitting as a group valued at \$2000.00AUS. The total prize pool is valued at \$2000AUS

Delivery of Prizes	Winners will have the payment amount transferred into their nominated bank account after the 2024 Deakin Alumni Awards event by completing a Deakin University ad hoc payment form that will be provided to complete.
