Staverton to Hampshire Hills Preferred Route

After considering landowner, neighbour and community feedback, TasNetworks has released a revised route for the Staverton to Hampshire Hills section of the North West Transmission Developments – the preferred route. The preferred route seeks to balance a range of objectives, including considering outcomes for landowners, local communities and businesses and the environment. Further engagement, in addition to field work and surveys, will soon commence to further inform the route finalisation process.

How has this route changed from the proposed route initially consulted on in late 2019?

Following the initial engagement process between October and December 2019, TasNetworks received requests for changes to the proposed route from landowners, neighbours and community groups. We then met with these interested parties to better understand their concerns and suggestions for realignment.

TasNetworks undertook further detailed investigations into variations to the proposed route, which considered landowner and community concerns and suggestions, together with other constraints and values. As part of the investigation process, TasNetworks undertook eagle nest surveys in late April and early May 2020.


Variations to the proposed route have now been assessed, and in some areas variations to the proposed route have been accepted as providing an overall better option, on balance. In other areas the proposed route remains unchanged.

The wide range of feedback received from our initial engagement process on the Staverton to Hampshire Hills transmission route has been considered. As a result, changes have been made to the proposed route that seeks to address a number of key issues and concerns raised by landowners and the community.

Map comparison

You can see how the route has changed in the map below. The transmission line we initially consulted on in late 2019 and early 2020 is shown in a dotted pink line. The preferred route is shown in a thick orange line.
